BRACKETS & HIGH-GAME: Scratch and Handicap brackets are \$5.00 each. High Game is \$25.00.

<u>TWO-DIVISION FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY</u>: HANDICAP DIVISION will bowl 5 games across 10 lanes with their total score determining the order of finish. SCRATCH DIVISION will bowl 5 games across 10 lanes with their total score determining the order of finish. THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE USBC AGE 16 AND OLDER WITHOUT RESTRICTION OR LIMITATIONS. Youth funds paid through SMART.

<u>OPTIONAL DOUBLES:</u> Bowlers may bowl with as many other people bowling in the same division. Their combined scores will determine their doubles standing. **BOWLERS MUST BE BOWLING IN THE TOURNAMENT SINGLES DIVISION IN ORDER TO BOWL DOUBLES!** Entry fee is \$10.00 per team and a team of the same pairing can only cash once per division.

<u>HIGH SENIOR & HIGH LADY OUT-OF-CUT</u>: All seniors age 55 and older and all women are automatically entered, but there must be at least 3 seniors for senior and 3 women for high lady in the division. The highest senior and highest woman out of the pay cut in the division will receive their entry fee back. The high senior and high lady CANNOT be the same person. The next highest out of cut score will cash.

IMPORTANT INFORMATON: ALL BOWLERS FOR THIS EVENT MUST PRE-REGISTER!!! FAILURE OF HANDICAP BOWLERS TO PREREGISTER WILL RESULT IN A \$10.00 WALK-IN FEE! <u>DIVISIONS:</u> This tournament will comprise of two divisions: The handicap division will be 80% of 230 with a max of 70 pins. The scratch division has no handicap. All bowlers must be current members of the USBC in good standing and must be least 16 years of age. Youth bowlers paid to their SMART account.

<u>AVERAGES:</u> The EBT shall use the highest reported/composite average of 21 games or more from the 2024-25 Bowl.com, the highest 2023-24 Bowl.com, or a current sanctioned league standing sheet of 21 games or more if neither of the previous ones apply. If none apply, the bowler shall bowl with a 230 scratch average. The ten pin rule is in effect for all handicap division bowlers and the bowler must report this average or they will be disqualified, see USBC rule 319a(2). All averages will be converted using the current USBC Sport Pattern conversion chart.

PRIZE FUND & FEES: The pay ratio shall be 1:5. Adult members will receive a payout following the tournament completion on Sunday, August 17, 2025. If the bowler is not present, the check shall be held until arrangements are made for delivery or mailed to the bowler if there is an address on file. Lineage is \$15.00 and Prize Fund is \$45.00 per entry. HDCP walk-ins pay a \$10 penalty fee. Top 6 based on 30 entries pays as: 1st \$600, 2nd \$300, 3rd \$150, 4th \$100, 5th \$80, 6th \$60. The prize fund and number of cashing spots will increase with additional entries but can decrease in the unlikely event there are less than 30 entries. All rules not listed here shall be governed by the current Elite Bowlers Tour and USBC rulebooks.
