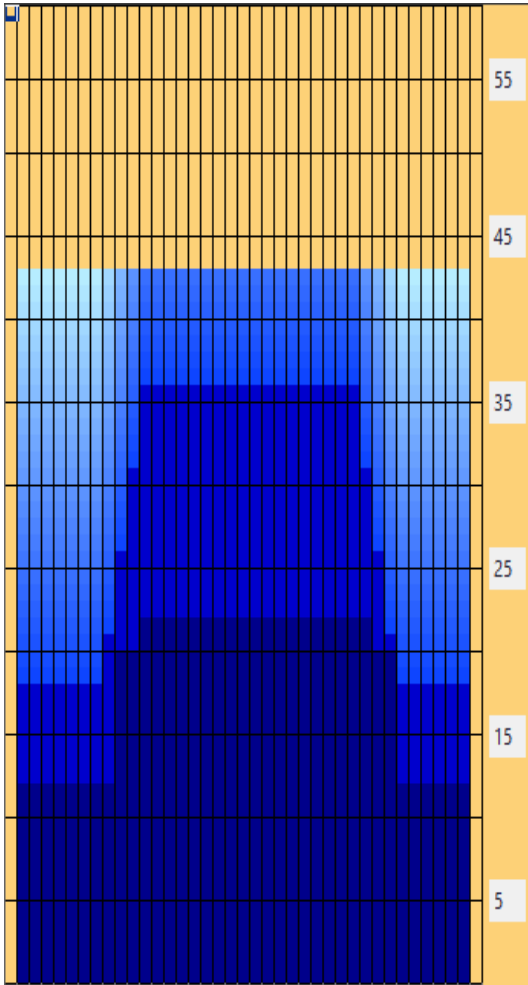




# ELITE BOWLERS TOUR

## Jupiter 43'



EBT Classification: ***Planet Pattern***

Pattern Volume: ***26.40mL @ 50 $\mu$ L***

Ratio: ***2.38 to 1***

Design Year: ***2016***

Description: Medium-Long sport pattern

Characteristics: Asymmetrical medium volume oil pattern

Recommended Attack Area: Second to third arrow

Recommended Delivery Speed: Moderate to Slow

Equipment: Aggressive balls that read early

Scoring Potential: Low to medium

Difficulty: Moderately Difficult

The EBT Jupiter 43' pattern is a long EBT proprietary pattern with an asymmetrical design. Jupiter is a flatter oil pattern that provides a little reaction on the backend. However, bowlers should be mindful that the backends opening up will take some time and work before they are realized. With a ratio of only 2.38 to 1 and 26.40mL of oil, Jupiter is designed to create carry down, and will also demand bowlers make consistent and accurate shots. However, its 43 foot length can also be a blessing in that bowlers who can play a tighter line may find the pocket more easily than those who cannot. Because bowlers will tend to migrate to the middle parts of the lane, as games prolong, a reverse block may start to develop depending on the skill of the bowlers crossing with you. Remember, you as the bowler are ultimately responsible for choosing the right equipment and playing the lanes as they allow you to play them! This is only a reference guide, not an answer key!
